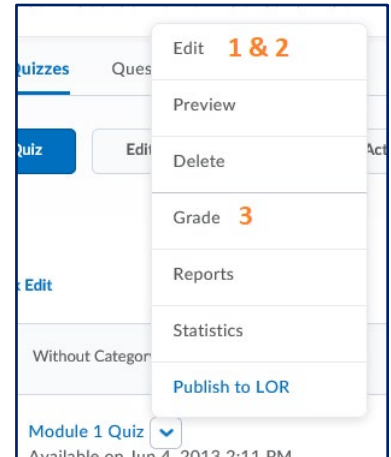


Four conditions need to be met for learners to view their quiz attempt(s), including the questions, student answers, correct answers, and any question or overall feedback the instructor may have provided. Instructors and learners can access quizzes from *Assessments > Quizzes* on the navbar.

- The first two conditions need to be met in *Edit Quiz* page, accessible from *Edit* option in the context menu.
- Third condition needs to be met after quiz grades and feedback are finalized from the *Grade Quiz* page; accessible from *Grade* option in the context menu.
- The fourth and last condition is communicating instructions on how to access the feedback to the students.

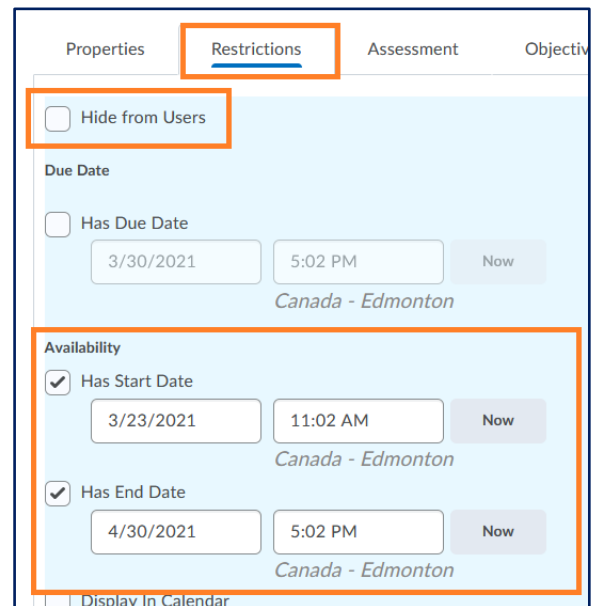


1. Quiz must be available

In the *Edit Quiz* page, *Restrictions* tab:

The quiz *Status* must be set to *Active*.


If start and end dates are set, the period you want the students to view their quiz feedback should fall within these dates and times.



2. Questions are visible in the submission view

In the *Edit Quiz* page, *Submission Views* tab:

The *Default View* link allows you to modify the information displayed to students after taking a quiz.



3. Quiz results are published

From the quiz context menu, choose the *Grade* option.




In the *Grade Quiz* page, list of attempts, make sure the quiz attempt results are published:

The *Status* indicates that the quiz results are published – i.e., visible to students. If it is not, Select the attempt (or all attempts) and click *Publish Feedback* option above the list.

4. Students know how to access their attempts and feedback
